A PROCLAMATION BY THE MAYOR OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA


WHEREAS, studies show that teen drinking is linked to risky behavior and injury; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Trade Commission has developed an educational campaign, "We Don't Serve Teens" providing information about teen drinking and how to reduce teens easy access to alcohol; and

WHEREAS, during "Don't Serve Teens Alcohol Week", public and private entities from across the District of Columbia will spread the word that serving alcohol to teens is unsafe, illegal and irresponsible:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THE MAYOR OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, do hereby proclaim September 10 – 14, 2007, as "**DON'T SERVE TEENS ALCOHOL WEEK**" in Washington, DC, and encourage citizens of the District of Columbia to work toward reducing teen access to alcohol.
