PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Teen drinking is linked to risky behavior and injury; and

WHEREAS, Most teens who drink obtain alcohol from social sources such as parties, older friends, and older adults; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Trade Commission has developed an educational campaign, "We Don't Serve Teens," providing information about teen drinking and how to reduce teens' easy access to alcohol; and

WHEREAS, It is critical that government and private entities work together to reduce underage drinking by stopping easy teen access to alcohol:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KATHLEEN SEBELIUS, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, do hereby proclaim the week of September 10-14, 2007 as
