underage drinking by stopping easy access to teen alcohol,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN E. BALDACCI, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby
proclaim September 10 - 14, 2007 as

WE DON'T SERVE TEENS WEEK

throughout the State of Maine, and urge all citizens to recognize this observance.
