**WHEREAS,** *Teen drinking is linked to risky behavior and injury; and*

**WHEREAS,** *Most teens who drink obtain alcohol from social sources, including at parties, from older friends and from other adults; and*

**WHEREAS,** *The Federal Trade Commission has developed an educational campaign, "We Don't Serve Teens," providing information about teen drinking and how to reduce teens' easy access to alcohol; and*

**WHEREAS,** *It is critical that government and private entities work together to reduce underage drinking by stopping easy teen access to alcohol.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,** *I, Dave Heineman, Governor of the State of Nebraska, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the week of September 10, 2007, as*

**WE DON'T SERVE TEENS WEEK**
