

Whereas, teen drinking is linked to risky behavior and injury; and

Whereas, most teens who drink obtain alcohol from social sources, including at parties, from older friends and other adults; and

Whereas, the Federal Trade Commission has developed an educational campaign, "We Don't Serve Teens," providing information about teen drinking and how to reduce teens' easy access to alcohol; and

Whereas, it is critical that government and private entities work together to reduce underage drinking by stopping easy teen access to alcohol;

Now, therefore, I, **Brad Henry**, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim the week of September 9 – 15, 2007, as

"The Don't Serve Teens Week"

in the State of Oklahoma,

and encourage government agencies, communities, and citizens to work toward reducing teen access to alcohol, using the resources available on www.DontServeTeens.gov and other available tools.
